## **POOL RULES**

\*POOL IS SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK!!\*

	All infants & children not toilet trained must wear swimming diapers (such as Little Swimmers by
	Huggies) and incontinent individuals need to wear plastic pants. Regular diapers are NOT
	allowed in the pool at any time.
J	Homeowners must have their assigned pool key fob with them while in the pool area.
J	All children must be accompanied by an adult.
J	The pool gate is to remain locked always. Use your key for access and DO NOT prop the gate
	open or give your key to others, DO NOT jump the fence.
J	Persons with skin, eye, ear or nasal infections or open sores and cuts, or communicable disease
	should not enter the pool.
J	No animals or pets are allowed in the pool or pool area.
J	No running, diving, rough play, pushing, or shoving in pool area.
J	Skateboards, bicycles, roller blades, etc. are not allowed in the pool area.
	No spitting, spouting of water, blowing nose, etc. allowed in the pool.
J	No glass, sharp objects, or hazardous materials allowed in or around the pool areas.
J	If at any time there is lightning or thunder, everyone is to get out of the pool immediately.
J	Anyone showing signs of intoxication will be asked to leave the pool area.
	No profane or abusive language will be tolerated.
J	Musical devices should be played at volumes that do not disturb others.
	Nudity is not tolerated in the pool area, children included.
	The pool is for use by dues paying members and their non-resident guests.
J	Homeowners must be present at the pool with their guests always.
	In the event of an emergency, please call 911.
	Everyone must clean up after him/herself. Trash cans are in and around the amenities area for
	trash.
	Do not leave floats or pool toys at the pool. Personal items left at the pool will be disposed of.
	Homeowners are limited to six (6) guests per home without prior approval from the Board of
	Directors.
	Everyone must always follow the directions of the lifeguard.

Please Note: The Health Department requires the pool to be closed for 24 hours if a fecal accident occurs in the pool. DO NOT enter the pool area anytime a closed sign is posted.
